### make good friendships with children

#### Top tips:

Enjoy each other's differences

Respect everyone

Be kind to everyone

Try not to lose your temper (if you do, stay calm, leave the person and talk to someone about how you feel)

have good friends  
be a good friend

## We want you to...

### make good friendships with adults

The children's team have been especially chosen to care for you. This means:

- » there should always be at least two adults with any group of children so you should never be on your own in a room with one adult
- » if you want to speak to an adult on your own, you can, but someone else should be around in the room as well
- » if you tell an adult a secret, they can't promise to keep it if they need to tell someone who can help you

An adult should not:

- » text you
- » email you
- » or talk to you on MSN without your parents/carers knowing about it and copying another adult into the messages
- » offer you a lift home in their car on your own
- » touch you in a way that makes you feel scared or uncomfortable
- » arrange to meet you on your own during the week

If an adult from The Salvation Army does any of these things, it is important that you tell someone:

- » your parents/carers
- » your children's leader
- » or write down what's happening on *time2talk*

## We want you to...


### learn how to be safe at home, at school and with your friends
