2 Timothy 1:5-14 Timothy

Here are some ideas and activities you could do on your own



Draw

Make a family scrapbook for Timothy's family. Draw pictures of his mother, grandmother, father, and then Paul and some of the events of Timothy's life (for example, reading Bible scrolls when a child, helping Paul write letters, his first preaching job in Ephesus...)



Make

Print out the chatterbox template below and make it. Play it with your family, asking and answering the questions together.



Serve

Can you do something to help children younger than you? Perhaps you could volunteer to help in the crèche or pre-school group when your Sunday school is back together. Perhaps you could offer to play with a neighbour's younger child for a little while. Perhaps you could help your parents look after your younger siblings.



Play

Gather some toys together and set up a school. What subject will you teach them? If you have any younger siblings or friends, you could ask them to play with you too.



Learn

Ask a member of your family or a friend to teach you something new. This could be a new skill, like keepie-uppies, baking a cake, or some new information. Find a willing volunteer who will let you teach them something too.



Read

There are some inspiring books that tell stories of how girls and boys had the courage and passion to make a big difference in the world; Irene Howat has written a series of books on this theme. They are called *Ten girls who changed the world*; *Ten girls who made history*; *Ten girls who used their talents*; *Ten boys who changed the world*; *Ten boys who made history* and *Ten boys who didn't give in*. Perhaps you could make a poster or slide presentation on one of the boys or girls who inspires you the most from these stories.
