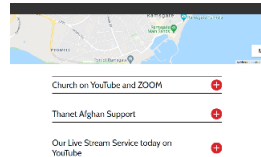
We meet at The Salvation Army Hall Sunday 10.30 am.

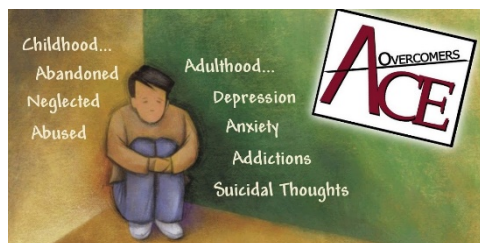

We are so excited to launch ACE Overcomers! For those of us who have experienced negative experiences growing up and struggle in adulthood with issues such as anxiety, anger, depression, addiction, low self-esteem, mental

health difficulties and physical ill health. We know these issues can have a huge impact on our quality of life, our relationships and our life opportunities.

This 12-week course starting Monday 11th helps us learn about ourselves and why we do what we do, and it teaches us practical strategies for living a healthier, happier life as we learn about God's heart for us and receive his healing.
