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WHAT IS INCLUDED...

- This innovative course is designed to equip all prospective volunteer children's leaders for their work with children, with other leaders, and with families within a Salvation Army context; and to provide learners with a taste of what it is like to work in the field of children's leadership.
- Mandatory course for children's leaders before they are commissioned as YPSM/Children's Ministry Team Leaders/Junior Soldier Sergeant.
- 9 online modules – can be worked through at an individual's own pace, and there is a comprehensive resource list of additional content for those wishing to deepen their learning in a specific area.
- There is a Learning Journal to accompany delegates throughout the training that includes key points from each module, a space for notes, activities and prompts for personal reflection.
- YCMU have a desire to create a learning community to share experiences and knowledge and are asking for people to register to start in one of 6 cohorts a year i.e. Jan, Mar, May, July, Sept and Nov.
- As part of a learning community – delegates will be invited to an online conversation half way through the timeframe to share learning and invited to join a closed FaceBook group to share experiences and resources going forward and stay connected as local children's leaders.
- Children's leaders who complete RAISE will be encouraged to join the bi-monthly online Children's Leaders' Network for ongoing learning.
