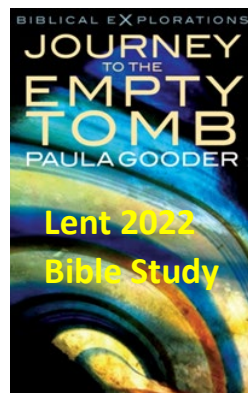

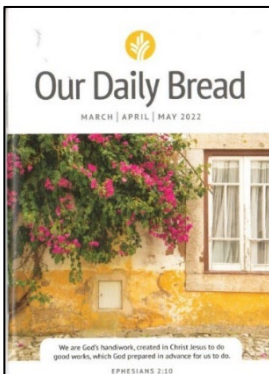

For **Paul**, husband of Sue who is the charity contact at Tesco and a great supporter of our work. Paul is undergoing tests for a spreading cancer.

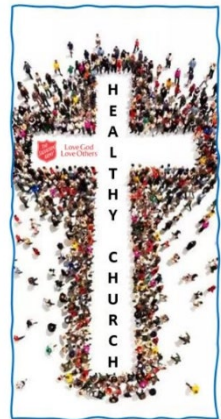
