Hello, I am Chris Stringer. I am part of the Community Services Team within the Mission Service. There are two of us who focus on the inclusion of people with a disability myself and Paska Moore who is the Disability Engagement Adviser.

We provide information, advice and guidance round the inclusion of people with a disability within The Salvation Army. This is wide ranging and encompasses things like community programmes, Corps and employment.

This also involves a good deal of awareness raising and training.

One of the things we are working on at the moment is giving advice to the organiser of Together 22 to make it as inclusive as possible.

We also have responsibility for enabled, a part of The Salvation Army which is for people with a disability. Through enabled we produce a regular newsletter which is by the members.

We have a weekly enabled prayer network which is circulated by email. An enabled Facebook group and an enabled WhatsApp group allows members to be in regular contact and to support each other.

We have a keeping in touch initiative in which we link enabled members with volunteers. The member and volunteer contact each other regularly and is a way of reducing loneliness and isolation.

We also organise enabled activities at a territorial, divisional, area or Corps level to allow enabled members to meet and enjoy a time of fellowship.
