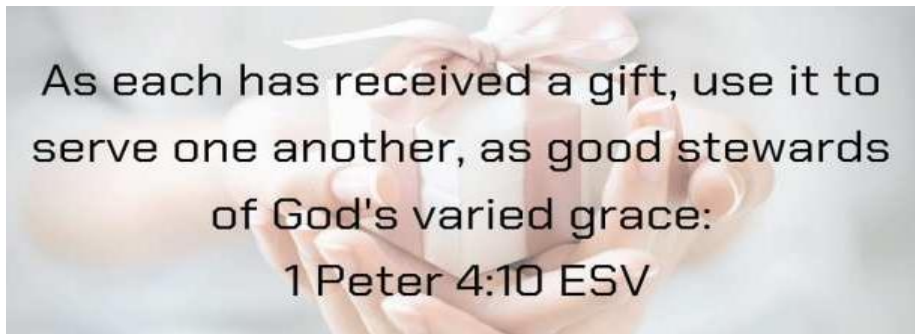
A GREAT BIG THANK YOU!
