THE BIG COLLECTION 2022

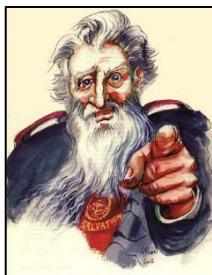
The Big Collection is a fundraising opportunity for members, friends, and volunteers of The Salvation Army to raise money for our social and community programmes.
