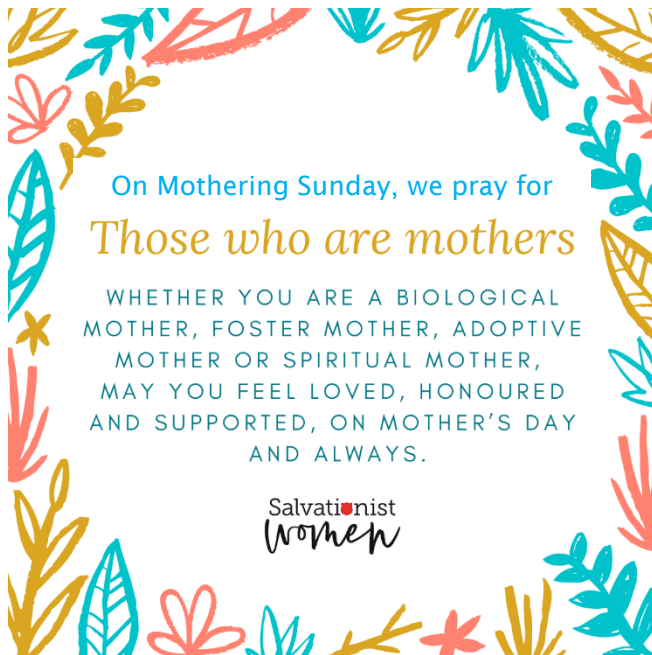
A warm welcome as we gather as the family of God today,
