# A call to prayer for the protection of rights for survivors of Modern Slavery

You may be aware that politicians are currently debating new legislation in parliament that, if passed, will have a significant impact on those who are trafficked to the United Kingdom and exploited in slave-like conditions. At this crucial moment we invite you to stand together in prayer for both victims of modern slavery and political leaders as they deliberate.

#### The Illegal Migration Bill

We are making this call to prayer now because we are concerned that the Illegal Migration Bill will have a devastating impact on victims of modern slavery. At present, all victims of modern slavery are entitled to specialist support and assistance in helping them recover. This bill will remove that right for thousands who have found themselves being tricked, traded and trapped through no fault of their own. Right now, politicians are considering all aspects of the bill in parliament. We, therefore, join together to pray for justice and righteousness.

- Politicians in parliament. May they have boldness, wisdom and compassion as they make decisions that will affect the most vulnerable people arriving on our shores.
