To take to your solicitor

When you have decided which type of gift you would like to leave to The Salvation Army, you can use the wording here to instruct your solicitor.

To leave a residuary gift and ensure The Salvation Army receives all or a share of whatever is left of your estate after you've provided for your loved ones:

"I give X% of the residue of my estate to The Salvation Army (Registered Charity No. 214779 and in Scotland SC009359), 101 Newington Causeway, London SE1 6BN for its general charitable purposes [and I request The Salvation Army but without imposing any binding trust or legal obligation to use the legacy for (insert name of project or area of work)] and direct that the receipt of the Legacy Manager or of any other appropriate officer for the time being of The Salvation Army shall be a good discharge to my Executors."

To leave a pecuniary or specific gift and donate a fixed sum of money or an item to The Salvation Army:

"I give £X (or the item specified) to The Salvation Army (Registered Charity No. 214779 and in Scotland SCoo9359), 101 Newington Causeway, London SE1 6BN for its general charitable purposes [and I request The Salvation Army but without imposing any binding trust or legal obligation to use the legacy for (insert name of project or area of work)] and direct that the receipt of the Legacy Manager or of any other appropriate officer for the time being of The Salvation Army shall be a good discharge to my Executors."
