

Hope you've had a good week. Mother Teresa (1910-1997) was a truly inspirational Christian Women of faith. She became a nun at the age of 19, lived and worked in India for 17 years and founded the Missionaries of Charity, always showing her compassion for humanity by caring for the uncared, oppressed, and poor. She was also awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. Here are some of her inspirational thoughts.

Bible verse for the week: 'But the wisdom that comes from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere'. (James 3:17 ESV)

Monday 15 January – 'Small things done with great love will change the world'. Pray that God will give you wisdom to see how you can make a difference in the world around you, by showing love in little acts of kindness.

Tuesday 16 January – 'Your true character Is most accurately measured by how you treat those who can do 'Nothing' for you'. Pray for the grace to always be sincere and impartial in the way we treat others.

Wednesday 17 January – 'Be kind and merciful. Let no one ever come to you without coming away better and happier. Be the living expression of God's kindness'. Prayer: 'Father, help me always to be welcoming and kind to others in my thoughts, my actions, and my words. Amen'.

Thursday 18 January – 'When you know how much God is in love with you then you can only live your life radiating that love'. Prayer: 'Lord, fill my life with Your love so that my life will be a reflection of Your love I pray'.

Friday 19 January – 'At the heart of silence is prayer. At the heart of prayer is faith. At the heart of faith is life. At the heart of life is service'. Thought: If you start each day in prayer, everything that follows will fall into place!

Saturday 20 January – 'We ourselves feel that what we are doing is just a drop in the ocean. But the ocean would be less because of that missing drop'. Thought: A drop of water causes a ripple that spreads in the water. Even the smallest drop is important.

Sunday 21 January – And a final thought from Mother Teresa ...

'May today be peace within. May you trust your highest power that you are exactly where you are meant to be. May you not forget the infinite possibilities that are born of faith. May you use those gifts that you have received and pass on the love that has been given to you. May you be content knowing you are a child of God. Let this presence settle into your bones, and allow your soul the freedom to sing, dance, praise, and love. It is there for each, and every one of you'. Amen.
