We pray for Mavis who remains unwell this week. And our prayers continue to go to Marilena who has experienced challenging weeks due to poor health.

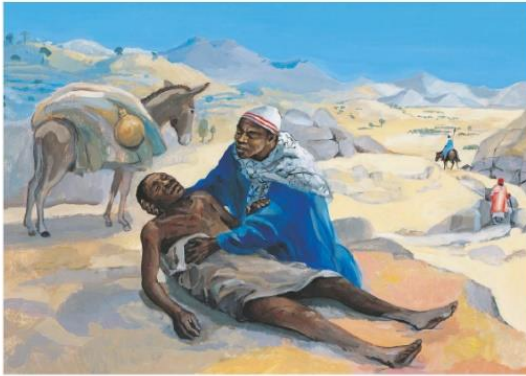
