Abigail spoke words of wisdom into a heated situation. **Is** God prompting you to speak wisdom into a challenging situation in your family, community or this church?

When it comes to giving our time, gifts, talents, and finances we can all demonstrate the characteristics of Nabal, David and Abigail:

We have moments where we see our wealth as our own and struggle to give generously.

We have moments where we are overwhelmed with frustration as others sit back and give little. We have moments where we recognise God's blessings in our life and give abundantly to others. In those moment we see that it is God who gave us everything in the first place.
