I love Easter and I am looking forward to the time that we will spend together throughout Lent focusing on the prayers of Jesus in our Lent Bible study, but also as we join together in Holy week reflecting afresh on all of the amazing events of that first Holy week. A week of course that culminated in the death of Jesus on the cross on Good Friday and His resurrection on Easter Sunday.

In that week we remember the triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday when the crowds welcomed Him chanting 'Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord.' (Luke 19:38) We remember how Jesus cleared the Temple of the money changers. How in the Olivet discourse He foretold the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem and the end of the age when Jesus would come again in power and glory. We remember His servant leadership when He washed the feet of the disciples before sharing in the Passover meal with them. We remember when He prayed in the Garden of Gethsemene that He would fulfil God's will for Him but also prayed for those who would follow. And we remember how He was betrayed by Judas and handed over to the authorities which culminated in His death on the cross.

Jesus was willing to set His face for Jerusalem to endure rejection and pain, to die a painful death on the cross, but to rise again so that we may all enjoy an intimate personal relationship with God that starts now, and stretches into the eternity that He prepares for all who accept His saving power into their lives, and who seek to live in the guiding power of His Holy Spirit.

I pray that this time of Lent and Easter will be a very special time in which as we remember again everything that Jesus has done for us, that we will all know afresh God's love and hope for ourselves that Jesus came to bring. And then I pray that we, emulating the example of Jesus, may continue to take up our cross in obedience to all that God asks of us in the days that lie ahead.
