

# **Coffee Morning**



April is a month of refreshment and cleansing so this week I would like to share Psalm 51 v 2 with prayer points and prophetic declaration.

Monday 15 April – Read Psalm 51 v 2. Prayer: Alpha and Omega, the King of Kings, your promises are true. I delight in your love. I glorify you forever in my life, the Author and



Finisher of my faith. (Song 30 'He giveth more grace as our burdens grow greater')

**Tuesday 16 April** – Read Luke 9 v 28-30. Prayer: Lord Jesus, I am excited to feel your full measure of grace, blessings and healing. I know the plans you have for me in April 2024 are plans of good and not evil. (Song 32 'How deep the Father's love for us')

**Wednesday 17 April –** Read Luke 9 v 51 and Luke 10 v12. Prayer: *I* am a child of God. My family and I belong to Jesus. I will continue to prosper under the canopy of God in this month of April in the mighty name of Jesus. (Song 61 'The King of love my Shepherd is')

**Thursday 18 April** – Read Luke 10 v 13-37. Prayer: *No weapon formed against me will prosper. I serve the God of Heaven and earth and for that reason the devil and his cohorts have no power over me. Jesus died for my liberation.* (Song 65 'There's the wonder of sunset at evening')

**Friday 19 April** – Read Deuteronomy 29 v 1-30. Prayer: *I am cleansed by the precious blood of Jesus. My past has no authority over my future. Obey the voice of the Lord.* (Song 72 'You can't stop rain from falling down')

**Saturday 20 April** – Read Deuteronomy 31 v 1-32. Prayer: O Lord, I thank you for all you are doing behind the scenes in my business, career, work. Through the name of Jesus I am victorious.' (Song 74 'At the name of Jesus')
