

PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 1 April – April the month associated with showers of rain. Well, we are no strangers to rain this year! Read Psalm 147 v 8-9. These verses are a true and wonderful promise to all. Take a walk If you can whatever the weather and enjoy the blessing of being alive in God's beautiful world. (Song 314 'There shall be showers of blessing')

Tuesday 2 April – Read Deuteronomy 32 v 2: 'Let my teaching fall like rain'. Consider 5 teachings of Jesus.1 God is One. 2 Everyone should develop brotherhood feelings about others. 3 Loving people in distress 4 Serve others without expecting anything in return. 5 Worship God. Pray for those responsible for teaching God's Word. (Song 624 'Teach me how to love thee')

Wednesday 3 April – Read Matthew 7 v 24-27. God's protection from storms. We all experience stormy days. Some people never recover from them. Consider daily storms encountered by people: The car breaks down on the school run – Sudden chronic ill health - Divorce - Financial concerns - Loneliness and many more. Pray for people to experience the peace of God. (Song 515 verse 4 'Out of your darkness he calls you, into the spring of his care')

Thursday 4 April – Read Isaiah 4 v 6. It will be shelter and shade from the heat of the day. How good it is to find shelter on a rainy day. There are three types of shelter: 1 Hasty - 2 Semi permanent – 3 Permanent. How important to seek the Lord who offers us permanent love and peace. Pray for the lost and lonely to secure permanent shelter in the Lord. (Song 998 verse 2 'Shelter for fragile lives')

Friday 5 April – Read Acts 14 v 17: 'He has shown kindness by giving you rain from Heaven and crops in their season. Some of the crops harvested on the allotment in April: Rhubarb - Aparagus- Purple sprouting broccoli – Radish - Spring cabbage - Spring onions. Delightful and all possible because of the blessing of rain. Pray prayers of thanksgiving today for His provision. (Song 390 'Give thanks every day for everything')

Saturday 6 April – Read 2 Samuel 23 v 4. Like the brightness after the rain. It is always wonderful to experience sunshine after the rain. When someone thanks you! A congratulatory message - an invitation to a special event. Try and give someone some good news today. PRAY for people to spread positive and good news today. (Song 216 verse 2 'Spread the good news o'er all the earth')

Sunday 7 April – Read Ezekiel 34 v 26: 'I will make the places around my hill a blessing and I will cause the shower to come down in its season'. Sunday is an opportunity to worship together at the Army and to experience numerous blessings from the Lord. A few blessings we cannot lose: We are chosen by God - We are offered forgiveness of sins - The riches of God's grace - Knowledge of God's will. Pray prayers of intercession for friends and family. (Song 258 verse 3 'Blessings abound where're he reigns')
