# PRAYER MATTERS

Bible verses this week are suitable for Autumn.

**Monday 7 October** – Read Genesis 8 v 22. Autumnal sounds include the crunching of leaves as you walk. What joy it is to walk during this season of change. Walking with the Lord is essential. Pray prayers of thanksgiving for all He has provided. (Song 364 'Give thanks with a grateful heart')

**Tuesday 8 October** – Read Psalm 104 v 19. During this Autumn season we often see and hear geese flying south. A fascinating sight and sound. This reminds us of God's amazing world and the beauty of nature. Read Psalm 104 words relating to the wonders of our world. Pray for all working to preserve our world. (Song 15 'For the fruits of his creation')

**Wednesday 9 October** – Read Ecclesiastes 3 v 1. During the Autumn season we can often hear the wind blowing through the trees again reminding us of the power and majesty of God. Read Ecclesiastes 3 today - all about time. In verse 2 it speaks about us doing good as we live. Pray that we will have the opportunity to help someone as we engage in our daily tasks. (Song 21 verse 2 'God speaks to us in far and near')

**Thursday 10 October** – Read Psalm 90 v 1. John Keats said 'This is the season of mist and mellow fruitfulness'. Consider and read Psalm 90 v 14: 'Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love'. What will you be doing this morning? Whatever your plans are pray that God will guide you in His ways and may the Lord establish the work of your hands. (Song 20 'God of the open spaces. God of the windswept sea, Lord of the lofty mountains, I open my heart to thee')

**Friday 11 October** – Read 2 Corinthians 9 v 10-11. In verse 11: 'You will be made rich in every way'. As Christians we are rich in receiving daily blessings from the Lord. Let us give thanks for these blessings.... The blessing of family... a safe and secure home... of daily provision... a Salvation Army Corps in which to worship and enjoy fellowship. (Song 57 'Singing to the Lord of harvest')

**Saturday 12 October** – Read 1 Timothy 4 v 4-5: 'For everything God created is good'. During the Harvest period we see just how amazing the creation of God is. The creation of light... the creation of the sky... the creation of plants, flowers, trees and wildlife, the sun, the moon and the stars. What a wonderful world! Pray for those devoid of a wonderful world because of war and famine caused by the actions of people. (Song 3 'All things bright and beautiful')

**Sunday 13 October** – Read Colossians 2 v 6-7: 'Continue to live in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught'. Try to attend God's house today to worship and to develop your Christian faith and service. Spend time in prayer, giving thanks to God for the blessings of Autumn: *Lord of the Harvest thank you for your generosity to us. For all the good things you have given us.* (Song 9 'Come, ye thankful people, come')
