PRAYER MATTERS

This week let's consider the word OCTOBER.

Monday 14 October – O is for Opportunity. Read 1 Corinthians 16 v 9: 'A wide door of opportunity is open for me and there are many adversaries'. Let us take hold of the spiritual opportunities afforded us, despite those that might discourage us. Be positive in declaring your faith today. (Song 401 verse 2 'Step by step we're moving forward')

Tuesday 15 October – C is for Committed. Read 1 Kings 8 v 61: 'May your hearts be fully committed to the Lord our God. To live by His decrees and obey His commands, as at this time' and Hebrews 11 v 6. Since the Covid pandemic it would seem that many people have abandoned their commitment to attending Sunday worship. It is vital that we remain committed to our service for the Lord. Pray fervently for people to rediscover their spiritual commitment. (Song 948 'Be strong in the grace of the Lord')

Wednesday 16 October – T is for Testimony. Read 1 Peter 3 v 15. Be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. Personal testimonies are powerful. So many people have become Christians through listening to the sincere testimonies of other Christians. When we get the opportunity let us give our testimony to the change Jesus has made to our daily living. (Song 842 'I have glorious tidings of Jesus to tell')

Thursday 17 October – O is for Offering. Read Luke 6 v 38: 'Give and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over'. Some quotes on giving ... '*Always give without remembering and always receive without forgetting*'. '*Giving does not only precede receiving it is the reason for it*'. Let us offer to the Lord our all. (Song 623 'Take my life and let it be consecrated, Lord to thee')

Friday 18 October – B is for Beginning. Read 2 Timothy 1 v 9: 'This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time'. Begin the day with God. He really wants you to. Hoping you will let Him come and spend the day with you. Rise up! Don't wait! You will miss the Son. It is the best part of the day. His taste is sweet, to all who meet Him in the morning, when he is fresh and new. (Song 664 'New every morning is the love, our wakening and uprising prove')

Saturday 19 October – E is for Encourage. A bible verse to encourage you is Joshua 1 v 9. Let us pray and endeavour to give others confidence and motivation to achieve their goals, contributing to a positive and nurturing community atmosphere. (Song 690 'Trust and Obey')

Sunday 20 October – R is for Radiance. A challenge for us to be bright and happy as we serve the Lord. I am sure that many people are encouraged if they witness a bright and prayerful church. If you are filled with light, with no dark corners, then your whole life will be radiant, as though a floodlight were filling you with light. Read 1 Peter 4 v 13. Keep on rejoicing. (Song 847 verse 3 'Rejoice, rejoice, O Christian, lift up your voice and sing')
