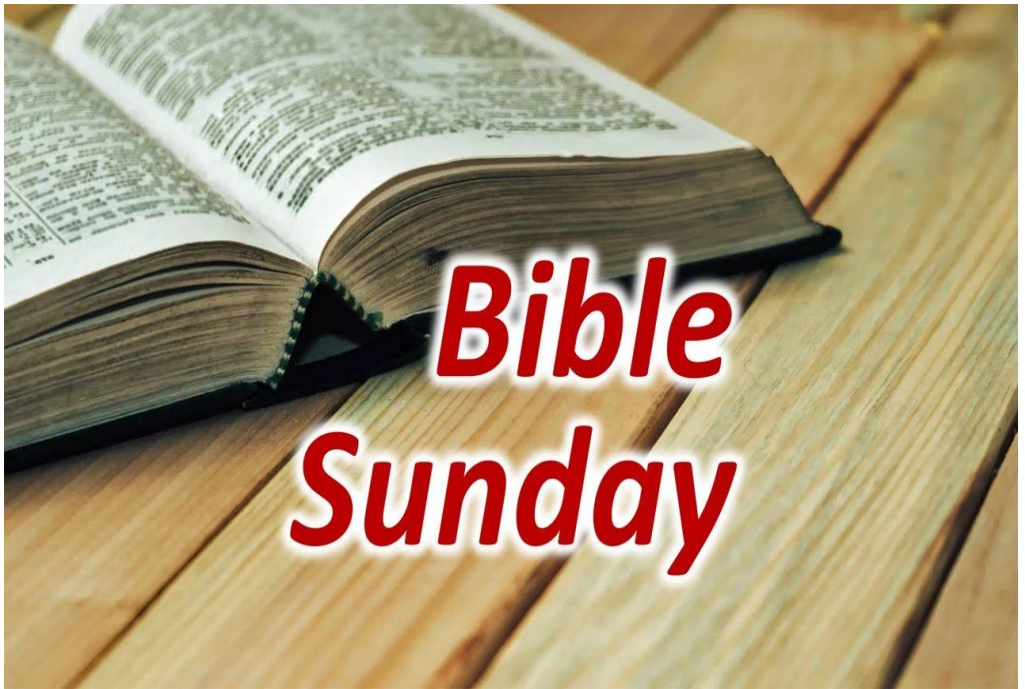

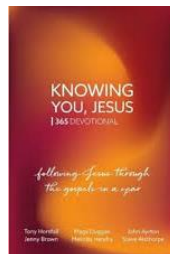

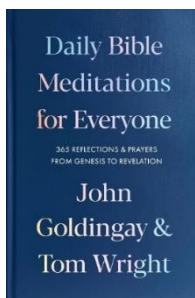
## Some ideas to follow on from ‘Knowing you Jesus’ devotional book

At the end of November, the ‘Knowing you Jesus’ devotional book many of us have been using will end. We hope this has been helpful to you in terms of establishing a daily rhythm of looking into God’s word and applying it to your life.

You may already have a plan of what to do next, but if not, here are a few ideas:



1. Use ‘**Knowing You Jesus**’ again and see what you see differently.
2. **Daily Bible Meditations for Everyone** – Goldingay & Wright



This is another 365 day devotional which covers passages from the Old Testament from January-July, and passages from the New Testament from August to December. This is “a book that promises to enrich your knowledge of the whole Bible while providing a clear path to understanding and applying God’s word in your daily life.” (available from Keith Jones Bookshop or Amazon, amongst others. Full price £19.99)

### 3. **Lectio 365 App**



This App provides a daily morning and evening devotional, including a bible reading, comment and prayers. It can either be read or listened to.

### 4. **The Bible with Nicky and Pippa App.**



This App has various plans to help to read the whole of the Bible in a year, with 3 readings a day. Each day also includes a commentary from Nicky Gumbel, comments from Pippa Gumbel and prayers.

5. BRF (Bible Reading Fellowship) Notes – Several different booklets usually covering a 4 month period. Prices around £5-£6. Hard copy or by email.
