Solicitors are available all over the country — you can choose a solicitor from a list — so you shouldn't need to travel far.

- 1. Call our friendly team on 020 7367 4800 or visit www.salvationarmy.org.uk/ freewillwriting to register your interest.
- 2. Then, we will refer you to the **National Free Wills Network**. They will send you a pack containing a list of your local participating solicitors and a form to complete.
- **3.** Contact your chosen solicitor to make an appointment, take along the form and get your simple Will written for free.



Home consultation




You may wish to write your Will during a home visit, by phone, or via video call with a qualified Will writing counsellor. We can offer you this free opportunity through **The Goodwill Partnership**, available if you live in England and Wales.

- 2. We will then refer you to **The Goodwill Partnership** and they will call you within three days to arrange an appointment at a time convenient for you.
- 3. Once your appointment has taken place and your Will has been drafted, it will be checked by a solicitor to make sure that it fulfils your wishes.
- 4. Your Will will be sent to you for witnessing and signing.





Online



Through our partnership with **MyIntent**, Will-making has never been easier to access. You can have your Will written free of charge, online and at your own pace.

Whether you want a simple Will written or have questions about your specific circumstances, MyIntent will connect you with a trusted solicitor to address your needs.

- **1.** Visit www.myintent.life/salvationarmy and complete the online Will interview, providing information on your circumstances and wishes.
- 2. After the interview, you will receive tailored online advice from one of MyIntent's trusted solicitors to review.
- 3. You will be offered a free optional 30-minute legal appointment to discuss this advice further. Or, if a free basic Will is suitable for you, you can choose to receive your Will without an appointment.
- 4. Receive your free Will by email with instructions on how to sign and witness it correctly. You can return a copy to the legal firm who will check it has been fully executed and securely store it for you, for free.
