There are many names for Jesus: Son of Man, Son of God, Prince of Peace, Emmanuel, Messiah. Although Jesus came to Earth as a humble servant, He is the King of kings. 1 Timothy 1:17 states, "Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honour and glory forever and ever.
