**BRINGING HOPE...**

As we look at the current news unfolding on our TV screens or read about events around the world in newspapers or on our phones and tablets, we may naturally feel helpless or a growing feeling of despair about what is being presented to us. Conflicts in many places including the current war in the Middle East may leave us feeling helpless, unable to say or do anything to make a difference. This feeling of helplessness is sadly part of the human condition and experience, but as followers of our Lord Jesus we have to believe that there is **HOPE** even when we feel that there is nothing else.

Imagine how the family, friends and followers of Jesus were feeling as they saw Him eking out the very last moments of his human life upon the cross at Golgotha; put there not for anything he had done but rather the sin and evil of the human condition. Their level of hopelessness must have been unfathomable.

**But HOPE** remained and that's why we call it Good Friday... or in old English, 'God's Friday'. This was God's moment to bring salvation and redemption to His suffering creation, to minister His grace to undeserving peoples, to show the depth of His Fatherly love to those He desired to be in relationship with: ***"For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life"*** (John 3:16) - what words of ultimate **HOPE** that not even physical death in this life can damage or destroy. Hallelujah!

And that's why we can still be people of hope despite all that is currently taking place in our communities or in the world as a whole...the empty cross of Good Friday is a reminder that the joy and miracle of resurrection on Easter Sunday is coming. May we this Easter time be **bringers of hope** to our families, to our friends and to our communities, living out Jesus in both words and actions for others to see. May we pray that boys and girls, men and women will seek Jesus because of us in these days.
