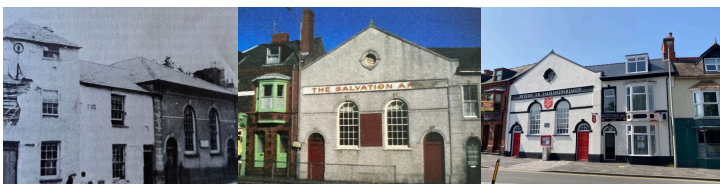


Recently in Bible Study we have been looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians. When we become followers of the Lord Jesus, accepting his salvation of our lives from sin, as well as his lordship over our new lives, we find ourselves 'in Christ', the term which Paul regularly deploys throughout his letter.

In chapter 3, Paul outlines the immeasurable height, width, length and depth of Christ's love for us and he prays that we will all come to our own knowledge and understanding of this. Have you stopped recently to reflect on how much Christ loves you?

Mark and I have been asked to speak to a local group this month interested in the archaeology of our Corps buildings. Rather than simply reflecting on the beautiful regency architecture of our facade, the old copper found in the basement or indeed the history of the Wesleyan Methodists in the building before we bought it in 1907, we have decided to incorporate in our presentation how the unquantifiable love of Jesus has overtaken the people who regularly have attended weekly worship or community programmes over so many years. For without the love of Christ being evident in his people-the church-then buildings such as ours would have very little role or purpose. Instead, we are able to testify that since our raising up nearly 144 years ago, lives in Aberystwyth have been transformed and continue to be transformed because of people encountering the life-changing, saving grace and love of God shown in Jesus and the daily indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Our mantra and mission continues to echo Paul's call to the Ephesians: "Love God:Love others", and in so doing we pray that the Kingdom of God may continue to be grown and people remain open to the love of Jesus in these days and in this place.
