I love the Salvation Army Songbook and this week will feature classic last line words from a selection of my most loved Songs. When you sing the last line of a song very often it will stay in your mind for some time.

Monday 20 July

Song 30 – *For out of his infinite riches in Jesus. He giveth, and giveth, and giveth again.*

Bible verse – Philippians 4 v 19: 'God will supply every need according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus'.

Offer your personal prayers thanking the Lord for your riches.

Tuesday 21 July

Song 79 (by General Albert Orsborn) – *Bring me at last to see the courts of God, that city fair, and find my name is written there.*

Bible verse – John 5 v 24: 'Whosoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life'.

Pray your personal prayers thank Him for the promise of eternity.

Wednesday 22 July

Song 795 – *In his arms he'll take and shield thee, thou wilt find a solace there.*

Bible verse – John 15 v 14: 'You are my friends if you do what I command you'.

Pray your personal prayers thanking God for His friendship.

Thursday 23 July

Song 628 – *Peacemaker, Lord! Now I am stirred to wonder. O take me, and my calling seal!*

Bible verse – Matthew 5 v 9: 'Jesus said, Blessed are the peacemakers, because they will be called the sons of God'.

Pray your personal prayers for peacemakers trying to resolve conflicts in all parts of our world.

Friday 24 July

Song 274 – *Thy touch, thy power are evermore the same. O man of Galilee!*

Bible Reading – John 6 v 1-2: 'Jesus crossed to the far shore of Galilee and a great crowd followed Him'.

Pray your personal prayers that the Lord will continue to touch our lives with His power and blessing.



Saturday 25 July

Song 302 – *Even me, even me, let some showers fall on me.*

Bible Reading – Ezekiel 34 v 26: 'And I will cause showers to come down in their season...they will be showers of blessing'.

Sunday 26 July
